

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Aged Care)



Course Purpose

This nationally recognised qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services; either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery. You will receive your CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support with 120 hours of mandatory industry placement, either through one of our Aged Care programs or through a current industry employer. The course is delivered through blended learning, with a combination of face to face training, self directed study and project work.

- Any Queensland resident aged 15 years or over who is no longer at school (with the exception of VET in Schools students),
- An Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and on the pathway to permanent residency,
- Prospective students must not have or be enrolled in a certificate III level or higher qualification (not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training)
